4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION
 5 93-313, R.C.M. 1947; TO PROVIDE THAT JUDGES HOLDING COURT IN
 6 OTHER COUNTIES RECEIVE ACTUAL MILEAGE COSTS."

 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 93-313, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to
 10 read as follows:

11 "93-313. Expenses of judges holding court in other
 12 counties. Each district judge of a judicial district in this
 13 state, composed of more than one county, when, for the
 14 purpose of holding court and disposing of judicial business,
 15 he goes to a county of his judicial district, other than the
 16 county in which he resides, and therein holds court or
 17 transacts judicial business, shall be paid all of his actual
 18 and necessary expenses of transportation and living,
 19 incurred on account thereof, and all expenditures made
 20 therefor, from the time he leaves his place of residence
 21 until he returns thereto. Actual and necessary expenses of
 22 transportation incurred when a judge uses his own automobile
 23 shall be ~~calculated at the rate of twelve cents (\$.12) per~~
 24 ~~mile~~ in an amount to be set by the supreme court in
 25 November of each year on a per mile basis. In computing the

1 per mile figure the supreme court shall do so based upon the
 2 actual operating costs and depreciation figures submitted to
 3 the supreme court in such manner as the court considers
 4 proper. The per mile figure determined in each November
 5 shall be used in determining actual automobile expenses
 6 until the following November."
