Actual and necessary expenses of 21 transportation incurred when a judge uses his own automobile 22 shall be calculated-at-the-rate-of-twelve-cents-(6-12)-per 23 mile; in an amount to be set by the supreme court in 24 November of each year on a per mile basis. - 1 per mile figure the supreme court shall do so based upon the
- 2 actual operating costs and depreciation figures submitted to
- 3 the supreme court in such manner as the court considers
- 4 proper. The per mile figure determined in each November
- 5 shall be used in determining actual automobile expenses
- 6 until the following November."
