 2 the plate. Such registration plate shall be treated with a
 3 reflectorized background material according to
 4 specifications prescribed by the registrar. An additional
 5 fee of fifty (50) cents per year for each registration of a
 6 vehicle shall be added to the registration fee. Revenue from
 7 this fee shall be forwarded by the respective county
 8 treasurers to the state treasurer for deposit in the motor
 9 vehicle recording account of the earmarked revenue fund.
 10 Disbursements from the motor vehicle recording account shall
 11 be made by warrant drawn by the registrar. The distinctive
 12 registration numbers shall begin with a number one (1) or
 13 with a letter-number combination such as "A 1" or "AA 1," or
 14 any other similar combination of letters and numbers and be
 15 numbered consecutively for each series of plates. The
 16 distinctive registration number or letter-number combination
 17 assigned to the vehicle shall appear on the plate preceded
 18 by the number of the county and appearing in horizontal
 19 order on the same horizontal base line, and the county
 20 number shall be separated from the distinctive registration
 21 number by a dash or a dot unless a letter-number combination
 22 is used. The dimensions of such numerals and letters shall
 23 be determined by the registrar of motor vehicles, provided
 24 that all county and registration numbers shall be of equal
 25 height.

1 (3) For the use of tax-exempt motor vehicles, in
 2 addition to the markings herein provided, number plates
 3 shall have thereon the following distinctive markings:

4 For vehicles owned by the state the registrar of motor
 5 vehicles may designate the prefix number for the various
 6 state departments, and all numbered plates issued to state
 7 departments shall bear the words "State Owned" and no year
 8 number will be indicated thereon as these numbered plates
 9 will be of a permanent nature, and will be replaced by the
 10 registrar of motor vehicles at such time when the physical
 11 condition of numbered plates require same. For vehicles
 12 owned by the counties, municipalities and school districts
 13 and used and operated by officials and employees thereof in
 14 line of duty as such, and for vehicles on loan from the
 15 United States government or the state of Montana, to, or
 16 owned by, the civil air patrol and used and operated by
 17 officials and employees thereof in the line of duty as such,
 18 there shall be placed on the number plates assigned thereto,
 19 in such position thereon as the registrar may designate, the
 20 letter "X" or the word "EXEMPT." Distinctive registration
 21 numbers for plates assigned to motor vehicles of each of the
 22 counties in the state and those of the municipalities and
 23 school districts situated within each of said counties shall
 24 begin with number 1 and be numbered consecutively.

25 (4) On all number plates assigned to motor vehicles of

1 the truck and trailer type, other than tax-exempt trucks and
 2 trailers, there shall appear the letter "T" or the word
 3 "TRUCK" for plates assigned to trucks and the letters "TR"
 4 or the word "TRAILER" for plates assigned to trailers, and
 5 housetrailer, and the letters "MC" or the word "CYCLE" for
 6 plates assigned to vehicles of the motorcycle type.

7 Number plates issued to a passenger car, truck, trailer
 8 or vehicle of the motorcycle type may be transferred only to
 9 a replacement passenger car, truck, trailer or motorcycle
 10 type vehicle.

11 (5) For the purpose of this act, the several counties
 12 of the state shall be assigned numbers as follows: Silver
 13 Bow, 1; Cascade, 2; Yellowstone, 3; Missoula, 4; Lewis and
 14 Clark, 5; Gallatin, 6; Flathead, 7; Fergus, 8; Powder River,
 15 9; Carbon, 10; Phillips, 11; Hill, 12; Ravalli, 13; Custer,
 16 14; Lake, 15; Dawson, 16; Roosevelt, 17; Beaverhead, 18;
 17 Chouteau, 19; Valley, 20; Toole, 21; Big Horn, 22;
 18 Musselshell, 23; Blaine, 24; Madison, 25; Pondera, 26;
 19 Richland, 27; Powell, 28; Rosebud, 29; Deer Lodge, 30;
 20 Teton, 31; Stillwater, 32; Treasure, 33; Sheridan, 34;
 21 Sanders, 35; Judith Basin, 36; Daniels, 37; Glacier, 38;
 22 Fallon, 39; Sweet Grass, 40; McCone, 41; Carter, 42;
 23 Broadwater, 43; Wheatland, 44; Prairie, 45; Granite, 46;
 24 Meagher, 47; Liberty, 48; Park, 49; Garfield, 50; Jefferson,
 25 51; Wibaux, 52; Golden Valley, 53; Mineral, 54; Petroleum,

1 55; Lincoln, 56; any new counties shall be assigned numbers
 2 by the registrar of motor vehicles as they may be formed,
 3 beginning with the number 57."
