The 13 governory---superintendent--of--public--instructiony-auditory secretary-of-statey--and--attorney--general--constitute--the 14 15 beard--ef--land--commissioners. There is a board of land 16 commissioners which consists of five (5) members appointed by the governor and confirmed by the senate to overlapping 17 18 terms as provided by law. It has the authority to direct, control, lease, exchange, and sell school lands and lands 19 20 which have been or may be granted for the support and

21 benefit of the various state educational institutions, under 22 such regulations and restrictions as may be provided by 23 law."

24 Section 2. Effective date. If approved by the 25 electorate this amendment is effective January 1, 1977.
