10 Section 1. Section 54-132, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to

12 "54-132. Criminal sale of dangerous drugs. (a) A 13 person commits the offense of a criminal sale of dangerous 14 drugs if he sells, barters, exchanges, gives away, or offers 15 to sell, barter, exchange or give away, manufactures, 16 prepares, cultivates, compounds or processes any dangerous 17 drug as defined in this-act section 54-301.

(b) A person convicted of criminal sale of dangerous
drugs shall be imprisoned in the state prison for a term not
less than one (1) year nor more than life.

(c) Practitioners and agents under their supervision acting in the course of a professional practice are exempt from this section."

24 Section 2. There is a new P.C.M. section numbered 25 54-132.1 that reads as follows: 54-132.1. Criminal cultivation of marijuana.
 (1) Each person who plants, cultivates, harvests, dries or
 processes any marijuana as defined in section 54-301, R.C.M.
 1947, or any part thereof, commits the offense of criminal
 cultivation of marijuana.

6 (2) A person convicted of criminal cultivation of 7 marijuana shall be imprisoned in the state prison for a term 8 not less than one (1) year nor more than twenty-five (25) 9 years.
