TO OF PUBLIC 6 THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER FOR VOCATIONAL 7 INSTRUCTION AS 8 EDUCATION AND GIVING THE BOARD OF PUBLIC EDUCATION THE RESPONSIBILITY FOR HIRING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER FROM AMONG 9 10 QUALIFIED APPLICANTS."

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12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 13 Section 1. Section 75-7702, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 14 read as follows:

15 "75-7702. Duties of board of public education. (1) The 16 board of public education shall be the governing board of the state of Montana for vocational education. The board of 17 public education shall adopt policies to effect the orderly 18 19 development of a system of vocational education that is adaptable to changing needs, controlled to prevent 20 unnecessary duplication, co-ordinated with federal guidelines 21 22 and requirements for vocational education, and funded to ensure growth and quality programming. In order to accomplish 23 the orderly development of a system of vocational education, 24 25 the board of public education policies shall include:

2 (2)--(b) standards for vocational education courses 3 and programs; 4 (c) instructor qualifications for vocational 5 education courses and programs; 6 (4)--(d) criteria for approval of vocational education 7 courses and programs which are to receive financial я assistance; 9 (5)--(e) a basis for apportionment of all moneys 10 appropriated by the legislature for vocational education in accordance with the intent of the legislature as reflected 11 12 in the terms of the appropriation; 13 (6)--(f) a basis for apportionment of all moneys received by the state of Montana for vocational education 14 from the federal government in accordance with the Acts of 15 16 Congress; 17 (7)--(g) a system of evaluation of vocational 18 education which allows for consideration of the current and 19 projected manpower needs and job opportunities; and 20 (8)--(h) any other policy not inconsistent with public 21 law and which is necessary for the proper operation of a 22 system of vocational education. 23 (2) The board of public education shall employ, from 24 among qualified applicants, the executive officer for

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vocational-technical education."

16 (12) approve or disapprove the adoption of a district's 17 emergency budget resolution under the conditions prescribed 18 in section 75-6725, and publish rules and regulations for an 19 application for additional state aid for an emergency budget 20 in accordance with the approval and disbursement provisions 21 of section 75-6729;

(13) generally supervise the school financial
administration provisions as prescribed by section 75-6802;
(14) appoint the responsible county officials for the
performance of the budgeting duties and the financial

administration duties for a joint district in accordance
 with the provisions of sections 75-6720 and 75-6803;

3 (15) prescribe and furnish the annual report forms to 4 enable the districts to report to the county superintendent 5 in accordance with the provisions of subsection (5) of 6 section 75-6806, and the annual report forms to enable the 7 county superintendents to report to the superintendent of 8 public instruction in accordance with the provisions of 9 section 75-5809;

10 (16) approve, disapprove or adjust an increase of the 11 average number belonging (ANB) in accordance with the 12 provisions of sections 75-6903 and 75-6904;

13 (17) distribute state equalization aid in support of
14 the foundation program in accordance with the provisions of
15 sections 75-6908, 75-6918, and 75-6919;

16 (18) estimate the state-wide equalization level for the
17 foundation program in accordance with the provisions of
18 section 75-6920;

(19) distribute state impact aid in accordance with the
 provisions of section 75-6925;

(20) provide for the uniform and equal provision of
transportation by performing the duties prescribed by the
provisions of section 75-7005;

14 Section 4. Section 75-7707, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 15 read as follows:

16 "75-7707. Post-secondary vocational-technical center 17 designation. Post-secondary vocational-technical centers 18 shall be designated by the board of education only upon 19 direction of the legislature. Applications for designation 20 must be made in accordance with the following procedure:

(1) The trustees of any high school district, of a
county high school, of a community college district, or the
governing board of any unit of the Montana university system
may submit an application for designation of a
post-secondary vocational-technical center to be operated by

1 such trustees or governing board. The application for 2 designation shall be submitted in accordance with the time, 3 data and form requirements prescribed by the board of 4 education. Applicant high school districts, county high 5 schools, or community college districts shall be located in 6 a county with a taxable valuation of at least forty-five 7 million dollars (\$45,000,000).

8 (2) Applications are to be presented to the superintendent--of-public-instruction-acting-in-his-capacity g 10 as-the executive officer for vocational education of the board of public education. The superintendent-of-public 11 12 instruction executive officer shall review the application and present it to the board of public education along with 13 14 his recommendations. The board of public education shall 15 then examine the application and recommendations of the 16 superintendent-of-public-instruction executive officer and 17 either adopt the recommendations of-the-superintendent-of 18 public-instruction or draft its own recommendations. The 19 application, together with all recommendations shall be 20 presented by the board of public education to the next following legislative assembly. 21

22 The board of <u>public</u> education shall recognize the 23 presently designated post-secondary vocational-technical 24 centers operated by the respective board of trustees of 25 school district number 1 of Silver Bow County, high school

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district number 1 of Lewis and Clark County, high school
 district "A" of Cascade County, Missoula County high school,
 and high school district number 2 of Yellowstone County."

4 Section 5. Section 75-7710, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 5 read as follows:

6 "75-7710. Local administration. The trustees or 7 governing board of a post-secondary vocational-technical 8 center shall administer such center according to the 9 requirements of the laws of the state of Montana, the 10 policies of the board of public education, and the regulations of the superintendent--of--public-instruction 11 12 executive officer for vocational education. If, in construing such laws, there is a conflict between the laws 13 14 providing for post-secondary vocational-technical centers and any other laws governing the operation of schools, the 15 16 former shall have the controlling authority."

17 Section 6. Section 75-7714, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to18 read as follows:

19 "75-7714. Pupil fees and disposition of collected fees. Fees for the use of equipment and material used in 20 instruction may be charged by the trustees or other 21 22 governing board of the post-secondary vocational-technical 23 center. The board of public education shall prescribe the basis and limitations for the charging of such fees. 24 25 Fees collected by the post-secondary

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vocational-technical center shall be deposited with the county treasurer in the fund designated by the superintendent-of-public-instruction executive officer for vocational education for the receipt of such fees. The expenditure of the fees shall not be subject to budget limitations and shall be in addition to the program budgets approved by the board of <u>public</u> education."

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
