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2**4** 25 BE IT EMACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Public road or way--easement by
11 prescription--elements of proof--procedure. A district
12 court may grant a decree recognizing an easement by
13 prescription for a public way or road to a petitioner who:

- (1) has filed a petition for such a decree accompanied by an affidavit signed by each of five (5) persons stating that each person has:
- (a) used the road or way at least once in each of five (5) years in a six (6) year period occurring during the twelve (12) year period previous to the filing of the action: and furthermore that:
- 21 (b) the landowner through whose land the road or way 22 passes did not oppose the use;
 - (c) there was no evidence known to them that the use of the road or way was permissive; and
 - (d) each user considered the road or way to be public.

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- 4 (a) the title of the court in which the petition is 5 filed; and
- (b) a description of the property involved; and
- 7 (3) has mailed a copy of the petition, affidavit and 8 notice of hearing ten (10) days prior to the date set for 9 hearing to the landowner.
- 10 (4) If no one appears to protest the content of this 11 petition the court may proceed to grant the decree.

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
