 Section 1. Section 82A-1201, R.C.M. 1947, is amended
 to read as follows:

 necessary for the enforcement of the wildlife laws.

3 (3) The salaries and expenses of state fish and game 4 wardens shall be paid out of the fish and game moneys in the 5 earmarked revenue fund and in the same form and manner as 6 they are paid upon the effective date of this act.

7 (4) A warden is vested with the powers of peace officers throughout the counties of the state when so 8 authorized by the director of the department. He may serve 9 criminal process and arrest and prosecute violators of the 10 11 law and has the same right as other peace officers to 12 require aid in executing his duties. These powers and 13 duties are supplementary, are not a limitation upon the powers and duties of other peace officers, and may be 14 executed only when authorized by the director of the 15 16 department.
