Section 1. Section 93-302, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

"93-302. Number of judges. In each judicial district there must be the following number of judges of the district court, who must be elected by the qualified voters of the district, and whose term of office must be six (6) years, to wit: In the first, second, eleventh, and sixteenth, and eighteenth, two judges each, in the thirteenth, eighth and fourth, three judges, and, in all other districts, one judge each."

Section 2. This act is effective January 1, 1976.
