BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 11-1024, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

"11-1024. Group insurance for all departments, bureaus, boards, commissions and agencies of the state of Montana, county, city, and town officers and employees--authority--approval of employees--limit on contributions. All departments, bureaus, boards, commissions and agencies of the state of Montana, and all counties, cities and towns shall upon approval by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the officers and employees of each such department, bureau, board, commission, agency, county, city and town, enter into group hospitalization, medical, health including long-term disability, accident and/or group life insurance contracts or plans for the benefit of their officers, employees and their dependents, and the respective

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administrative and governing bodies shall pay for such insurance ten dollars (\$10) per month for each officer, and employee,--and--provided--for--employees--of--educational institutions--whose-employment-contracts-show-at-a-minimum-a full-time-academic--year--of--employment--such--payment--for insurance--may--be--an-amount-equal-to-twelve-(12)-times-the monthly-rate, employee, and legislator, and provided for full-time seasonal employees who are employed on a regular basis at least eight (8) months of the fiscal year and for members of the legislature, such payment for insurance may be an amount equal to twelve (12) times the monthly rate, but may not exceed one hundred twenty dollars (\$120) per year. Provided, however, that for employees of elementary and high school districts premium contributions are not subject to the ten dollar (\$10) limitation of this section."

Insert: "(2) In this section, as it applies to a person employed in the executive or legislative branches of state government, "employee" means:

(a) a permanent full-time employee as defined in section 59-1007.1;

(b) a part-time employee as defined in section 59-1007.1 who is scheduled to work at least twenty (20) hours per week;

(c) a person employed in a seasonal position as defined in section 59-1007.1 who is employed on a regular basis at least eight (8) months of the fiscal year."

23 (B) A PART-TIME EMPLOYEE AS DEFINED IN SECTION
24 59-1007.1 WHO IS SCHEDULED TO WORK AT LEAST TWENTY (20)
25 HOURS PER WEEK;

1 (C) A PERSON EMPLOYED IN A SEASONAL POSITION AS
2 DEFINED IN SECTION 59-1007.1 WHO IS EMPLOYED ON A REGULAR
3 BASIS AT LEAST EIGHT (8) MONTHS OF THE FISCAL YEAR."

4 SECTION 2. THIS ACT IS EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE AND
5 APPROVAL.
