4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS  
 5 84-1842 AND 84-1843, R.C.M. 1947, RELATING TO SPECIAL FUEL  
 6 USER'S TEMPORARY TRIP PERMITS, TO PROVIDE FOR NONRESIDENT  
 7 AGRICULTURAL HARVESTING EQUIPMENT SPECIAL FUEL PERMITS."  
 8

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 84-1842, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to  
 11 read as follows:

12 "84-1842. Special fuel user's temporary trip permits  
 13 -- nonresident agricultural harvesting equipment special  
 14 fuel permit -- agents by whom issued.

15 (1) Any person operating a special fuel-powered  
 16 vehicle upon the public roads and highways of this state who  
 17 fails or neglects to carry in the vehicle a valid special  
 18 fuel vehicle permit, as provided by section 84-1833, shall  
 19 be required to purchase a special fuel user's temporary trip  
 20 permit. The permits will be issued by scale house personnel,  
 21 gross vehicle weight (g.v.w.) patrol crews, Montana highway  
 22 patrolmen, and such other enforcing agents as the department  
 23 of revenue may prescribe by order, rule or regulation.

24 (2) Any nonresident upon entering the state of Montana  
 25 with agricultural harvesting equipment powered by special

1 fuel and operating upon the public roads and highways of  
 2 this state who fails or neglects to carry in or on equipment  
 3 a valid special fuel vehicle permit, as provided by section  
 4 84-1833, shall be required to purchase a nonresident  
 5 agricultural harvesting equipment special fuel permit. The  
 6 permit will be issued by scale house personnel, gross  
 7 vehicle weight (g.v.w.) patrol crews, Montana highway  
 8 patrolmen and such other enforcing agents as department of  
 9 revenue may prescribe by order, rule or regulation."

10 Section 2. Section 84-1843, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to  
 11 read as follows:

12 "84-1843. Fees for temporary permits -- time of  
 13 expiration -- disposition of fees -- forms. (1) The  
 14 temporary special fuel permits shall cost the special fuel  
 15 vehicle user a fee of twenty dollars (\$20.00); said permit  
 16 shall be valid for a period of time not to exceed  
 17 seventy-two (72) hours and will be automatically void should  
 18 said vehicle leave the state of Montana during the  
 19 seventy-two (72) hour period. All fees collected will be  
 20 remitted to the state department of revenue. Special fuel  
 21 temporary permits, remittance forms and any other necessary  
 22 papers for the accounting and enforcement of this act shall  
 23 be furnished by the state department of revenue.

24 (2) A temporary special fuel permit for a nonresident  
 25 operating agricultural harvesting equipment shall cost

1 thirty dollars (\$30) per unit for a period beginning July 1  
2 and ending October 31. The permit shall not be  
3 transferable. A unit shall be defined as:

4 (a) One (1) truck suitable for hauling produce, and

5 (b) One (1) harvesting machine, and

6 (c) Pick-up trucks and any other accessory vehicles.

7 All fees collected shall be remitted to the department of  
8 revenue. Nonresident temporary permits, remittance forms  
9 and any other necessary papers for the accounting and  
10 enforcement of this act shall be furnished by the department  
11 of revenue."
