BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Salary increases for employees of the department of institutions shall be retroactive to January 1, 1975, for employees of record at time of passage and approval of this act. Salary increases shall be as follows:

- 1. Professional and craft personnel \$100 per month
- 2. Support personnel \$133 per month
- 3. Direct care personnel \$149 per month
