INTRODUCED BY

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FIFTY-FOUR THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF REIMBURSING LEWIS AND CLARK COUNTY FOR COSTS RELATED TO HOLDING THE NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL RODEO IN HELENA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the general fund the sum of fifty-four thousand eight hundred dollars (\$54,800) to the department of administration for the purpose of reimbursing Lewis and Clark County for costs related to holding a national high school rodeo at the Lewis and Clark County fairgrounds.

The treasurer of Lewis and Clark County may present verified claims to the department of administration for each expense for which reimbursement is claimed and the department shall pay such claims from the moneys appropriated by this act. Such expenses may be accumulated and presented to the department as a single claim.

Section 2. If there are moneys remaining after authorized expenses have been paid, they shall revert to the general fund.
