A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY TO DEVELOP THE NEWLAND CREEK RECREATION AREA FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30. 1977: AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION. " 7

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 9

Section 1. For the purposes of this act. 10 otherwise stated: 11

- 12 (1) "Agency" includes all state offices, departments, divisions, boards, commissions, councils, committees, 13 14 institutions, units of the university system, and other 15 entities or instrumentalities of the executive branch, offices of the legislative branch, or office of the judicial 16 17 branch of state government.
 - (2) "Capital project" means acquisition of land or improvements, planning, capital construction, renovation, furnishing and major repair projects authorized in this act.
- (3) "Approved budget amendment" means approval by the 21 22 budget director of a request submitted through the construction and maintenance division of the department of 23 24 administration to:
- (a) obtain financing for a new or expanded project 25

from funds which were not available for consideration by the legislature, but which have become available, or

(b) transfer excess funds appropriated to a capital project within an agency to increase the appropriations of another capital project within that agency.

Section 2. No new capital project may be established and no existing capital project may be expanded beyond the scope of the project as approved by the legislature in the 1977 biennial budget unless the new capital project or the 10 capital project expansion is authorized by an approved budget amendment. 11

Section 3. If a capital project is jointly financed by an appropriation or appropriations from state sources as well as by appropriations from other sources, the funds provided by appropriation from state sources shall be decreased by the amount that the funds received from other sources exceeds the amount from other sources appropriated by the legislature in the 1977 biennial budget, provided that:

- 20 (1) the decrease does not jeopardize the receipt of 21 the funds to be received from other sources, and
- (2) the additional funds are to be expended for a new 22 or expanded project approved by the budget director upon 24 request submitted to him through the construction and maintenance division of the department of administration.

1	Section 4. When an agency receives federal funds as a
2	reimbursement for the cost of administering a federal
3	program and this cost was financed by an appropriation from
4	state funds, the cost must be transferred from the state
5	fund to the federal and private revenue fund unless usage of
6	the federal funds is restricted by federal provisions.
7	Section 5. The following money is appropriated from
8	indicated funds and accounts to the director, department of
9	administration, for the biennium ending June 30, 1977, for
10	the indicated capital projects.
