A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TEMPORARY FOREST-WORK PROGRAM TO PROVIDE EMPLOYMENT FOR CITIZENS OF THE STATE OF MONTANA IN PROJECTS FOR THE MAINTENANCE, CONSERVATION AND IMPROVEMENT OF THE FOREST LANDS OF THE STATE, AND APPROPRIATING TWO--HUNDRED--THIRTY NINETY THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 1975, AND TWO--HUNDRED--SEVENTY ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 1977; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. The following moneys are appropriated:

(1) TO THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION

THIS APPROPRIATION IS FOR CAPITAL AND OPERATIONAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH RECEIPT OF FEDERAL FUNDS ON AT LEAST A ONE-TO-ONE MATCHING BASIS TO PAY SALARIES FOR EMERGENCY EMPLOYMENT, AND IF SUCH FEDERAL FUNDS ARE NOT FORTHCOMING, THE ABOVE AMOUNTS SHALL REVERT TO THE GENERAL FUND.

Section 2. Any funds unexpended from section 1 (1) of this appropriation as of June 30, 1975 are reappropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1976.

Section 3. The Governor, or his designated representative, may approve a request submitted through the budget director to:

(1) expand the program from funds that were not available for consideration by the legislature but which have become available from a source other than the state's general fund; or

3 during the second fiscal year of the biennium.

4           Section 4. The moneys appropriated by this act shall  
5 be used to establish a temporary forest-work program to

8 LAND AND SLASH DISPOSAL ON PRIVATE FOREST LANDS WHERE SLASH  
9 DISPOSAL IS THE OBLIGATION OF THE STATE.
