4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY
5 FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 1977,

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. For the purposes of this act, unless
11 otherwise stated:

12 (1) "Agency" means each state office, department,
13 division, board, commission, council, committee,
14 institution, unit of the university system, and other entity
15 or instrumentality of the executive branch, office of the
16 legislative branch, or office of the judicial branch of
17 state government.

18 (2) "Capital project" means acquisition of land or
19 improvements, planning, capital construction, renovation,
20 furnishing and major repair projects authorized in this act.

21 (3) "Approved budget amendment" means approval by the
22 budget director of a request submitted through the
23 construction and maintenance division of the department of
24 administration to transfer excess funds appropriated to a
25 capital project within an agency to increase the

1 appropriations of another capital project within that
2 agency.

3 Section 2. No new capital project may be established
4 and no existing capital project may be expanded beyond the
5 scope of the project as approved by the forty-fourth
6 legislature.

7 Section 3. If a capital project is jointly financed by
8 an appropriation or appropriations from state sources as
9 well as by appropriations from other sources, the funds
10 provided by appropriation from state sources shall be
11 decreased by the amount that the funds received from other
12 sources exceeds the amount from other sources appropriated
13 by the legislature in the 1977 biennial budget, provided
14 that the decrease does not jeopardize the receipt of the
15 funds to be received from other sources.

16 Section 4. All federal funds received as a
17 reimbursement for the cost of administering the federal
18 funds when the cost was financed from the general fund shall
19 revert to the general fund.

20 Section 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
21 the remaining balances on capital projects previously
22 appropriated are hereby reappropriated until June 30, 1977,
23 for the purposes for which originally appropriated.

24 Section 6. If any section, subsection, sentence,
25 clause, or phrase of this act is for any reason held

HOUSE BILL NO. 712

INTRODUCED BY BARDANOUVE, SOUTH

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR THE BIENNIUM ENDING JUNE 30, 1977, AND PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATIONS."

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(3) "Approved budget amendment" means approval by the budget director of a request submitted through the construction and maintenance division of the department of administration to transfer excess funds appropriated to a capital project within an agency to increase the

appropriations of another capital project within that agency, OR TO OBTAIN FINANCING TO EXPAND A PROJECT FROM FUNDS WHICH WERE NOT AVAILABLE FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE LEGISLATURE, BUT WHICH HAVE BECOME AVAILABLE.

Section 2. ~~No new capital project may be established and no~~ existing capital project may be expanded beyond the scope of the project as approved by the forty-fourth legislature UNLESS THE CAPITAL PROJECT EXPANSION IS AUTHORIZED BY AN APPROVED BUDGET AMENDMENT.

Section 3. If a capital project is jointly financed by an appropriation or appropriations from state sources as well as by appropriations from other sources, the funds provided by appropriation from state sources shall be decreased by the amount that the funds received from other sources exceeds the amount from other sources appropriated by the legislature in the 1977 biennial budget, provided that the decrease does not jeopardize the receipt of the funds to be received from other sources.

Section 4. All federal funds received as a reimbursement for the cost of administering the federal funds when the cost was financed from the general fund shall revert to the general fund.

Section 5. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the remaining balances on capital projects previously appropriated are hereby reappropriated until June 30, 1977,

1 for the purposes for which originally appropriated.

2 Section 6. If any section, subsection, sentence,
3 clause, or phrase of this act is for any reason held
4 unconstitutional or void, such decision shall not affect the
5 validity of the remaining portions of this act.

appropriations of another capital project within that agency, OR TO OBTAIN FINANCING TO EXPAND A PROJECT FROM FUNDS WHICH WERE NOT AVAILABLE FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE LEGISLATURE, BUT WHICH HAVE BECOME AVAILABLE.

Section 2. No ~~new-capital-project-may-be-established~~ and ~~no~~ existing capital project may be expanded beyond the scope of the project as approved by the forty-fourth legislature UNLESS THE CAPITAL PROJECT EXPANSION IS AUTHORIZED BY AN APPROVED BUDGET AMENDMENT.

Section 3. If a capital project is jointly financed by an appropriation or appropriations from state sources as well as by appropriations from other sources, the funds provided by appropriation from state sources shall be decreased by the amount that the funds received from other sources exceeds the amount from other sources appropriated by the legislature in the 1977 biennial budget, provided that the decrease does not jeopardize the receipt of the funds to be received from other sources.
