 13 department of highways will free the present highways
 14 building for use by other state agencies; and

15 WHEREAS, several state agencies and departments, are in
 16 need of centralized working facilities; and

17 WHEREAS, House Joint Resolution 75, adopted by the 1974
 18 Legislature requested the preparation of a construction
 19 project; and

20 WHEREAS, the spirit and goals of that resolution can be
 21 fulfilled without the necessity of a capital outlay; and

22 WHEREAS, the department of agriculture, the department
 23 of livestock, and the department of natural resources and
 24 conservation, are in need of centralized working facilities;

25 WHEREAS, the office space needs of the aforementioned

1 departments are more compatible with the space that will
 2 become available in the present quarters of the department
 3 of highways; and

4 WHEREAS, section 82-3308, Revised Codes of Montana,
 5 1947, authorizes the department of administration to assign
 6 space in state office buildings to state agencies.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. (1) The department of administration shall
 10 assign space in the present highways building, upon
 11 completion of the new highways complex, to the following
 12 state departments and in the following order of priority:
 13 first to the departments of agriculture and livestock; and
 14 second to the department of natural resources and
 15 conservation.

16 (2) The department shall assign such space with the
 17 purpose of maintaining each department's Helena based

WHEREAS, House Bill 576, of the Forty-fourth Legislature authorizes the construction of a new complex to house the department of highways; and

WHEREAS, completion of a new building for the department of highways will free the present highways building for use by other state agencies; and

WHEREAS, several state agencies and departments, are in need of centralized working facilities; and

WHEREAS, House Joint Resolution 75, adopted by the 1974 Legislature requested the preparation of a construction project; and

WHEREAS, the spirit and goals of that resolution can be fulfilled without the necessity of a capital outlay; and

WHEREAS, the department of agriculture, the department of livestock, and the department of natural resources and conservation, are in need of centralized working facilities;

WHEREAS, the office space needs of the aforementioned

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departments are more compatible with the space that will become available in the present quarters of the department of highways; and

WHEREAS, section 82-3308, Revised Codes of Montana, 1947, authorizes the department of administration to assign space in state office buildings to state agencies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. (1) The department of administration shall assign space in the present highways building, upon completion of the new highways complex, to the following state departments and in the following order of priority: first to the departments of agriculture and livestock; and second to the department of natural resources and conservation.

(2) The department shall assign such space with the purpose of maintaining each department's Helena based offices, in their entirety, in a single central location. WHEN CONSIDERING ASSIGNMENT OF SPACE UNDER THIS ACT, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INSURE THAT THOSE DEPARTMENTS WITH FIRST PRIORITY ARE PROVIDED SUFFICIENT SPACE FOR FUTURE GROWTH, AND THAT GROWTH OF FIRST PRIORITY DEPARTMENTS, FOR PURPOSES OF SPACE ASSIGNMENT, TAKES PRECEDENCE OVER GROWTH OF SECOND AND THIRD PRIORITY DEPARTMENTS.
