Such conversion can only be made upon the written application of the injured workman, his beneficiary, or major or minor dependents, as the case may be, and shall rest in the discretion of the beard division, both as to the amount of such lump-sum payment and the advisability of such conversion. The beard division is hereby vested with full power, authority, and jurisdiction to compromise claims and to approve compromises of claims under this act; and all settlements and compromises of compensation provided in this act shall--be

- absolutely--null--and are void without the approval of the
- 2 board division. Any approval of the board division must be
- 3 in writing and set forth specifically the reasons for such
