 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AMENDING SECTION  
 5 92-706.1, R.C.M. 1947, RELATING TO MEDICAL BENEFITS UNDER  
 6 THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT, BY ADDING A PROVISION  
 7 REQUIRING THE EMPLOYER OR INSURER TO REPAIR OR REPLACE  
 8 DAMAGED OR LOST EYEGLASSES AND DENTURES."

 10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 92-706.1, R.C.M. 1947, is amended  
 12 to read as follows:

13 "92-706.1. Medical and hospital services approved by  
 14 the division are furnished. (1) In addition to the  
 15 compensation provided by this act and as an additional  
 16 benefit separate and apart from compensation, the following  
 17 shall be furnished:

18 (a) During the first thirty-six (36) months after the  
 19 happening of the injury, the employer or insurer shall  
 20 furnish reasonable services by a physician or surgeon,  
 21 reasonable hospital services and medicines when needed, and  
 22 such other treatment as may be approved by the division for  
 23 the injuries sustained. The division, upon application of  
 24 the injured workman may, for good cause, grant reasonable  
 25 extensions of the benefits provided in this section.

1 (b) The employer or insurer shall replace or repair  
 2 eye glasses and dentures that are damaged or lost as a  
 3 result of an injury, as defined in section 92-418, arising  
 4 out of and in the course of employment.

5 (2) All hospitals must submit to the division of  
 6 workmen's compensation, a schedule of fees and charges for  
 7 treatment of injured workmen to be in effect for at least a  
 8 twelve (12) month period unless the division and the  
 9 hospital agree to interim amendments of the schedule. The  
 10 schedule must be submitted at least thirty (30) days prior  
 11 to its effective date and shall not exceed the charges  
 12 prevailing in the hospital for similar treatment of private  
 13 patients."
