DURING AN AUCTION ONLY ONE CARCASS OF EITHER DEER, MOOSE, OR ELK SHALL BE PURCHASED PER PERSON. AT THEIR DISCRETION, THE FISH AND GAME DEPARTMENT MAY DONATE UNSOLD CARCASSES TO WELFARE DEPARTMENTS, PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS, OR CHARITABLE INSTITUTIONS."
