Section 1. There is a new R.C.M. section numbered 92-617 that reads as follows:
92-617. Payments by insurer prior to a hearing -- reimbursement. If an insurer terminates biweekly compensation benefits and the termination of compensation benefits is disputed by the claimant, the division may, upon written request, order an insurer to pay additional biweekly compensation benefits prior to a hearing; but in no event may the biweekly compensation benefits be ordered to be paid under this section for a period exceeding forty-nine (49) days or for any period subsequent to the date of a hearing. If after a hearing it is held that the insurer was not liable for the compensation payments ordered by the division, the insurer has the right to be reimbursed for such payments by the claimant.
