Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.
•	DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:
3 1	An act to allow a retired volunteer fireman to receive a volunteer fireman's pension even though he is receiving benefits from another retirement system.
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FISCAL IMPACT:

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Under the volunteer firemen's retirement system, no minimum benefit is statutorily established. Benefits each year are prorated to the eligible retired fireman based on 95% of the previous year's income subject to a maximum benefit of \$50 per month. The income to the fund is currently sufficient to pay all retirees the maximum \$50 per month. I creasing the number of persons eligible for benefits would not require increased funding under current fund income projections. In the event that 95% of the previous year's fund income would not be sufficient to pay the maximum benefit, all retirees under the system would receive a lesser prorated share.
