11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Interest owned by person other than owner 12 of surface -- abandonment -- claim of interest -- vesting of 13 interest. Any interest in oil, gas, or other minerals in 14 any land owned by anyone other than the owner of the 15 surface, which has not been devised, sold, leased, mortgaged 16 or transferred by instrument recorded in the office of the 17 clerk and recorder in the county where such interest is 18 located for a period of twenty-five (25) years shall, in the 19 20 absence of the actual production of oil, gas, or other minerals from such land, or from lands covered by a lease to 21 which such interest is subject, or from lands pooled, 22 unitized, or included in unit operations therewith, during 23 such period of twenty-five (25) years, be deemed abandoned, 24 25 unless the owner thereof, within three (3) years after the

1 effective date of this act or within twenty-five (25) years after the last devise, sale, lease, mortgage, or transfer of 2 record of such interest or actual production of oil, gas, or 3 other minerals from such land, or from lands covered by a 4 5 lease to which such interest is subject, or from lands 6 pooled, unitized, or included in unit operations therewith. 7 whichever is later, records a claim of interest as provided 8 in this act. Any interest in oil, gas, or other minerals g. deemed abandoned as herein provided shall vest as of the 10 date of such abandonment in the owner of the surface.

11 Section 2. Preservation of interest -- notice --12 contents. Any interest in oil, gas, or other minerals 13 referred to in this act may be preserved by the recording 14 within the period specified in this act a verified written 15 notice in the clerk and recorder's office for the county 16 where such interest is located, describing the land and the 17 nature of the interest claimed, giving the name and address 18 of the person or persons claiming the interest, and stating 19 that such person or persons desire to preserve the interest 20 and do not intend to abandon same. This recording of notice 21 preserves such interest from abandonment for a period of 22 twenty-five (25) years thereafter. If the nondormant 23 character of the interest has not been evidenced by sale, lease, mortgage, or transfer by instrument recorded in the 24 25 clerk and recorder's office for the county where such

1 interest is located; oil, gas, or other minerals have not 2 been actually produced from those lands, or from lands 3 covered by a lease to which such interest is subject, or from lands pooled, unitized, or included in unit operations 4 5 therewith; or a like notice filed, such interest shall be deemed abandoned. In the absence of prior abandonment, such 6 interests may be preserved indefinitely by the filing of 7 notices or by other actions evidencing nondormancy of the 8 9 interest in accord with this act at intervals of not more 10 than twenty-five (25) years.
