A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 16-1164, R.C.M. 1947, TO INCREASE THE MILL LEVY FOR COUNTY MUSEUMS FROM ONE HALF TO THREE QUARTERS."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 16-1164, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

"16-1164. Tax levy for support of museums. The board of county commissioners of any county now owning, or hereafter acquiring any such museum or collection of exhibits, may make an appropriation in its annual budget for the upkeep, care, maintenance, operation and support thereof, and to meet and take care of such appropriation may annually levy a tax of not to exceed ~~one-half--(1/2)~~ three quarters (3/4) mill on each dollar of the taxable valuation of the property subject to taxation in the county, which levy shall be made at the same time as other levies are made for county and school purposes. The proceeds from the collection of such levy shall be kept in a special fund by the county treasurer and used solely for the purpose for which such levy was made."
