DESCRIPTION OF LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 198 provides for a 5% tax on gross receipts from parimutuel betting.

ASSUMPTIONS:

Parimutuel betting gross receipts for 1974 were \$4,252,712. Approximately the same gross receipts are anticipated during the next two years.

FISCAL IMPACT:

CONCLUSION:

Enactment of Senate Bill 188 would provide approximately \$430,000 in increased revenue during the biennium.
