(1) No member of a 13 utilization review committee of a hospital or of a 14 utilization committee of a statewide or local society 15 composed of doctors of medicine or doctors of osteopathic 16 medicine and surgery or of a peer review or professional standards review committee of a statewide or local society 17 composed of doctors of medicine, doctors of osteopathic 18 19 medicine and surgery, doctors of dentistry, chiropractors, 20 doctors of. optometry, or registered pharmacists shall be 21 liable in damages to any person for any action taken or 22 recommendation made within the scope of the functions of the 23 committee, if the committee member acts without malice and in the reasonable belief that the action or recommendation 24 25 is warranted by the facts known to him, after reasonable effort to obtain the facts of the matter for which the
 action is taken or a recommendation is made.
