- (2) The department of intergovernmental relations or its successor, a county, a city, or a duly constituted airport authority may apply for and hold one (1) public airport retail liquor license and one (1) retail beer license, each to be used at each airport owned and operated by said department, county, city, or airport authority.

be issued in the name of the public agency operating the airport and may not be transferred to another person, except
