11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Section 75-6810, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to

13 read as follows:

14 "75-6310. Procedure for issuance of warrants. The

trustees of each district shall issue all warrants and the

warrants shall identify:

17 (1) the sudgeted fund or nonbudgeted fund on which the

is warrant is drawn;

1) (2) the appropriation item of the budgeted fund or the

type of expenditure for a nonbudgeted fund on which the

21 warrant is grawn; and

22 (3) the warrant as an emergency warrant, if it is drawn

23 on an emergency budget.

Any warrant issued by a district shall be countersigned

25 by the chairman of the trustees and the clerk of the

district before the warrant shall be negotiable. Facsimile

2 signatures may be used in accordance with the provisions of

3 chapter 13 of Title 59, R.C.M., 1947, provided that the

4 facsimile signature device shall not-be-available-to-the

5 other-countersigner-of-the-warrant- be used and stored in

6 the best possible manner available to the district to assure

safekeeping of it.

The trustees shall issue warrants in single copy or in triplicate copy. When the warrants are issued in single copy, the trustees shall immediately provide a listing of 10 the issued warrants on a fund-by-fund basis to the county 11 treasurer and retain a copy of the listing in the district 12 13 accounting records. When the warrants are issued in triplicate, the original copy of the warrant shall be delivered to the payee; the duplicate shall be sent 15 immediately to the county treasurer; and the triplicate 16 shall be retained by the district for accounting record 17 purposes. The duplicate and triplicate copies shall be 18 19 identified on the face of the warrant "Not Negotiable -- Copy of Original. " 20

21 However, the trustees may elect to issue warrants in

22 payment of wages and salaries on a direct deposit basis to

23 the employee's account in a local bank, provided the consent

24 of the employee has been obtained and the employee is given

25 an itemized statement of payroll deductions for each pay

l period."
