 2 INTRODUCTION BY *Senate* BILL NO 266

 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO CREATE A BOARD OF
 5 INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS; PRESCRIBING ITS MEMBERSHIP,
 6 DUTIES, MEETINGS, AND COMPENSATION."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Board created -- membership -- duties --
10 meetings -- compensation. (1) There is created a state
11 board of intergovernmental relations. A simple majority of
12 its membership constitutes a quorum for doing business.

13 (2) The board shall consist of seven (7) members,
14 appointed by the governor as follows:

15 (a) three (3) members from the public at large who
16 shall be qualified by experience and interest in
17 intergovernmental affairs;

18 (b) two (2) members appointed from a list of four (4)
19 names submitted to the governor by the league of cities and
20 towns; and

21 (c) two (2) members appointed from a list of four (4)
22 names submitted to the governor by the Montana association
23 of counties.

24 (3) The board is assigned to the department of
25 intergovernmental relations for administrative purposes

1 only, and the terms of the members shall be in accordance
2 with section 82A-112.

3 (4) In addition to its duties as prescribed in section
4 82A-108, the board shall have the authority to review and
5 comment upon department functions, and evaluate and rule on
6 procedural rules promulgated by the department.

7 (5) The board shall meet as often as so requested by
8 the governor or the director of the department, but not less
9 than twice annually.

10 (6) Members of the board shall be compensated from the
11 funds of the department at the rate of twenty-five dollars
12 (\$25) per day, or for their actual and necessary expenses,
13 while engaged in the duties of the board.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED REGULATIONS:


An act to create a seven member board of Intergovernmental Relations.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The Board would meet four times per year for 2 days.
2. No additional staff or office expense would be required for the Board.
3. Members of the Board will be compensated for actual expenses rather than \$25 per day. Actual expenses will average \$85 per member per meeting.
