DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Senate Bill 291 provides that motor vehicle number plates shall be issued for a minimum period of four years and that those issued in 1976 shall be a graphic change commemorating the bicentennial celebration of the founding of the United States.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Cost estimates are based upon budget information received from the license plate manufacturing division of the state prison.
- 2. Approximately 120,000 sets of license plates per year will be issued after the year of original issue.
- 3. Additional equipment amounting to \$91,650 is needed in 1976 to purchase the graphic bicentennial plate. \$42,600 of this equipment would have to be purchased to replace worn equipment by 1979 under any alternative.
- 4. Costs include \$80,000 per year tag production when appropriate.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The following four-year period estimates are being provided to portray various license plate alternatives:

CONCLUSION:

Enactment of Senate Bill 291 would result in four-year reductions in license plate expenditures of \$439,063. (\$2,074,485 (column 4) versus \$1,635,422 (column 1))

All-number-plates-for-motor-vehicles-shall-be 13 issued--every--other--yeary-provided-that-number-plates-will 14 next-be-issued-in-the--year--1973--and--in--alternate--years 15 thereafter,--shall--bear-a-distinctive-marking,-and-shall-be 16 furnished-by-the-state;-In--alternate--years--the--registrar 17 shall--provide--nonremovable--stickers--bearing--appropriate 18 registration-numbers-which-shall-be-affixed-to--the--license 19 plates-in-use. (2) In the case of motor cars and trucks, number plates 3 shall be of metal six inches wide and twelve inches in 5 length, the number plates issued in the year 1976 to be of a graphic design commemorating the bicentennial of the 6 founding of the United States of America, and the word 7 8 "Montana" with the year placed across-the-bottom-of ON the 9 plate. For number plates issued after 1976, the outline of the state of Montana shall be used as a distinctive border 10 on such license plates, and the word "Montana" with the year 11 shall be placed across the bottom of the plate. Such 12 registration plate shall be treated with a reflectorized 13 14 background material according to specifications prescribed by the registrar. An additional fee of fifty (50) cents per 15 year for each registration of a vehicle shall be added to 16 the registration fee. Revenue from this fee shall be 17 forwarded by the respective county treasurers to the state 18 19 treasurer for deposit in the motor vehicle recording account of the earmarked revenue fund. Disbursements from the motor 20 21 vehicle recording account shall be made by warrant drawn by 22 the registrar. The distinctive registration numbers shall 23 begin with a number one (1) or with a letter-number 24 combination such as "A 1" or "AA 1," or any other similar combination of letters and numbers and be numbered 25

1 consecutively for each series of plates. The distinctive registration number or letter-number combination assigned to 3 the vehicle shall appear on the plate preceded by the number 4 of the county and appearing in horizontal order on the same 5 horizontal base line, and the county number shall be separated from the distinctive registration number by a dash 6 er--a-det separation mark unless a letter-number combination 7 is used. The dimensions of such numerals and letters shall 8 9 be determined by the registrar of motor vehicles, provided 10 that all county and registration numbers shall be of equal 11 height.

(3) For the use of tax-exempt motor vehicles, in addition to the markings herein provided, number plates shall have thereon the following distinctive markings:

For vehicles owned by the state the registrar of motor vehicles may designate the prefix number for the various state departments, and all numbered plates issued to state departments shall bear the words "State Owned" and no year number will be indicated thereon as these numbered plates will be of a permanent nature, and will be replaced by the registrar of motor vehicles at such time when the physical condition of numbered plates requires same. For vehicles owned by the counties, municipalities and school districts and used and operated by officials and employees thereof in line of duty as such, and for vehicles on loan from the

- 1 United States government or the state of Montana, to, or owned by, the civil air patrol and used and operated by 3 officials and employees thereof in the line of duty as such, 4 there shall be placed on the number plates assigned thereto, 5 in such position thereon as the registrar may designate, the letter "X" or the word "EXEMPT." Distinctive registration 6 7 numbers for plates assigned to motor vehicles of each of the counties in the state and those of the municipalities and 8 9 school districts situated within each of said counties shall 10 begin with number 1 and be numbered consecutively.
 - (4) On all number plates assigned to motor vehicles of the truck and trailer type, other than tax-exempt trucks and trailers, there shall appear the letter. "T" or the word "TRUCK" for plates assigned to trucks and the letters "TR" or the word "TRAILER" for plates assigned to trailers, and housetrailers, and the letters "MC" or the word "CYCLE" for plates assigned to vehicles of the motorcycle type.
