DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to establish the amount of compensation and expenses to which the Board of Trustees of the Historical Society are entitled.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The board is composed of 15 members who meet four times per year. The five member Executive Board meets every sixty days.
- 2. Computations are based on 80 more days at \$25 per day plus mileage, meals and lodging at \$63 per day.
- 3. It is assumed that all members would exercise their option of claiming reimbursement for expenses.

CONCLUSION:

Enactment of Senate Bill 343 would result in an increase in expenditures of an estimated \$13,310 during the biennium, assuming all members would claim full compensation. Past experience indicates that many board members do not claim expenses, therefore, actual expenditures may be reduced by as much as 50%.
