"Food manufacturing establishment" 17 (2)means a commercial establishment, and buildings or structures in 18 19 connection with it, used to manufacture or prepare food for sale or human consumption, but does not include milk 20 producers' facilities, milk pasteurization facilities, milk 21 product manufacturing plants, slaughterhouses, or meat 22 23 packing plants.

24 (3) "Meat market" means a commercial establishment, and25 buildings or structures in connection with it, used to

process, store, or display meat or meat products for sale to
 the public or for human consumption, but does not include an
 establishment where wild game is cut and wrapped on a custom

(5) "Frozen food plant" means a place used to freeze,
process, or store food including facilities used in
