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4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION  
5 23-3003, R.C.M. 1947, PERTAINING TO DEPUTY REGISTRARS BY  
6 REQUIRING INSTRUCTION IN REGISTRATION FOR NOTARIES,  
7 REGISTERING VOTERS; AND DELETING THE REQUIREMENT OF  
8 TAXPAYING STATUS FOR DEPUTY REGISTRARS."

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10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
11 Section 1. Section 23-3003, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to  
12 read as follows:

13 "23-3003. Notaries public as deputy registrars --  
14 appointment of additional deputies -- qualifications --  
15 duties. (1) All notaries public are deputy registrars in the  
16 county in which they reside. They may register electors  
17 residing in any precinct within the county. No notary  
18 public may register any voter until he has been issued a  
19 certificate of approval by the county registrar certifying  
20 that he has received instructions on registration procedure  
21 from the county registrar.

22 (2) The commissioners shall appoint a minimum of two  
23 (2) deputy registrars who are not notaries public, a minimum  
24 of one (1) from each of the two (2) major political parties,  
25 for each precinct in the county from lists of persons

1 recommended by the political parties. If the parties fail to  
2 submit lists, the commissioners shall appoint deputy  
3 registrars without recommendations from the parties. The  
4 number of appointed deputy registrars for each county shall  
5 always be equally divided between the two (2) major  
6 political parties. A deputy registrar shall:

7 (a) Be a qualified ~~taxpaying~~ resident elector in the  
8 precinct for which he is appointed;

9 (b) Register electors residing in any precinct in the  
10 county;

11 (c) No duly appointed deputy registrar shall register  
12 any voter until such deputy registrar shall have been issued  
13 a certificate of approval by the county registrar,  
14 certifying that said deputy registrar has received  
15 instructions on registration procedure from the county  
16 registrar.

17 (3) Within three (3) days after a registration card is  
18 filled out, deputy registrars shall forward the card to the  
19 registrar. Registration cards properly executed prior to the  
20 registration deadline shall be accepted by the registrar for  
21 three (3) days after the deadline."
