BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:  
Section 1. Article XIV, section 8 of the Montana constitution is amended to read as follows:

"Section 8. Amendment by legislative referendum. Amendments to this constitution may be proposed by any member of the legislature. If adopted by an affirmative roll call vote of two-thirds of ~~all~~ the members ~~thereof~~ ~~whether--one--or--more--bodies~~ of each house, the proposed amendment shall be submitted to the qualified electors at the next general election. If approved by a majority of the electors voting thereon, the amendment shall become a part of this constitution on the first day of July after certification of the election returns unless the amendment provides otherwise."

Section 2. When this amendment is submitted to the qualified electors of Montana, there shall be printed on the ballot the full title and section 1 of this act and the following words:

For changing the constitution to require two-thirds of the members of each house to adopt a constitutional amendment to be submitted to the people.

For leaving the constitution as it is requiring a two-thirds vote of all legislators taken together to adopt a constitutional amendment to be submitted to the people."
