House Bill No. 16

TO GENERALLY REVISE THE LAWS RELATING TO STATE PARKS.

(This summary does not include discussion of routine form or grammatical changes.)

Section 1. 62-301. Deleted "that" as unnecessary.

Section 2. 62-306. This section provides a penalty for a violation of the fish and game rules regarding state parks which is inconsistent with the penalty provision in 62-314. Although 62-134 is an earlier section, it was amended twice after passage of 62-306, which has never been amended. 62-314 would have to be considered the latest expression of legislative intent and the penalty there provided should govern. Accordingly, the penalty provision of this section In recodification the two sections 62-306 and is deleted. 62-314 will be combined.

Section 3. Deleted "that" as unnecessary. 62-310.

Section 4. 62-311. Rewritten for clarity.

Section 5. 62-314. This section, being part of the same act as 62-312, contemplates land used for "camping" and "recreational" use, as well as state parks. The opportunity was taken here to specifically extend the penalty provision to all types of areas and property administered by the department of fish and game in this respect, by adding "park, recreational area, monument, or historical site".
