In compliance with a written request received January 6, 19 77, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for House Bill 66 pursuant to Chapter 53, Laws of Montana, 1965 - Thirty-Ninth Legislative Assembly.

Background information used in developing this Fiscal Note is available from the Office of Budget and Program Planning, to members of the Legislature upon request.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to create a Fire Services Training School.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. School will employ a mobile concept requiring six (6) fully equipped trucks. Equipment will include audio visual equipment such as 16mm and 35mm projectors, projection screens, video tape camera, recorder and monitor, and cassette players and recorders; a breathing air compressor and cascade system; and a hose coupler. Also, six fifth-wheel simulator trailers will be required, fully equipped.
2. Eight (8) instructors are necessary six (6) of which will be assigned to regions.
3. The School will train the fire service in all factions of the fire service, from entry through officership.
4. A training school is currently operating at the Great Falls Vo-Tech Center and is state funded.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Fire services training school -- creation -- allocation to the board of public education. There is a fire services training school. The fire services training school is allocated to the board of public education for purposes of planning and coordination. The budget request for the fire services training school shall be included with the budget request of the board of public education. The governance, management, and control of the school is vested in the board of public education.

Section 2. Purpose of fire services training school. The purpose of the fire services training school is to:

- (1) reduce the loss of life and personal injury caused by fire;
- (2) reduce property damage and loss caused by fire;
- (3) provide paid, volunteer, and other publicly or privately employed firefighters with professional training at minimum cost;
- (4) provide training in investigating the cause of

 - (7) provide public educational programs to promote fire prevention.
- Section 3. Fire services training advisory council.
