### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION

This bill is an act to change the amount allowed for delinquent taxes when computing levies for state purposes from 12% to 6%; amending sections 84-713 and 84-3803, R.C.M. 1947.

### FISCAL IMPACT

This bill has no fiscal impact. The bill reduces the allowance for delinquency in computing state taxes levied from 12% to 6%. Historical data has shown 6% to be ample.
