### DESCRIPTION OF LEGISLATION

An act requiring that all members of the legislature resign prior to becoming candidates for other elective offices whenever the term for which they were elected to the legislature overlaps the term of the other office, and to provide for the filling of vacancies so created.

## ASSUMPTIONS

- 1. Cost to state is minimal.
- 2. Counties bear costs of elections.
- 3. Cost of special election is as follows:
  - a. Per county cost for supplies, printing, and salaries \$10,000
  - b. Per precinct cost for election judges \$350
- 4. The largest legislative district in the state consists of 6 counties and 50 precincts; the smallest legislative district consists of 1 county and 1 precinct.

### FISCAL IMPACT

No cost to the state.

LOCAL IMPACT

Each special election would cost from \$10,350 to \$77,500 per legislative district. If the election as required were held with a regular election, the additional cost would be from \$50 to \$500 per legislative district.
