DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to require fire protection services for certain state-owned buildings and authorizing payment for such protection.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. Additional inspections of state-owned buildings by the Fire Marshall will be required to determine present particular fire fighting problems.
2. An additional three (3) FTE employees will be required by the Department of Administration to administer the program.
3. All fire protection services for state-owned facilities that require protection will be provided by local fire districts.
4. The average mill levy for fire protection will be ten (10) mills.
