The 16 staff personnel in each county shall consist of at least one 17 gualified staff worker (or investigator) and such clerks and 13 stenographers as may be decided necessary. If conditions 19 warrant, the county board, with the approval of the state 20 21 department, may appoint some fully qualified person listed 22 by the state department as supervisor of its staff 23 personnel. The staff personnel of each county department are 24 directly responsible to the county board, but the state 25 department shall have the authority to supervise such county

14 Section 2. Saving clause. This act does not affect 15 rights and duties that matured, penalties that were 16 incurred, or proceedings that were begun before the 17 effective date of this act.

Section 3. Severability. If a part of this act is invalid, all valid parts that are severable from the invalid part remain in effect. If a part of this act is invalid in one or more of its applications, the part remains in effect in all valid applications that are severable from the invalid applications.
