8 Section 1. Definitions. As used in this act, the

12 government subdivision, government agency, local government,  
13 or other organization or entity.

14 (2) "Nuclear waste" means any radioactive waste,  
15 solid, liquid, or gaseous, resulting from a nuclear  
16 conversion facility.

17 Section 2. Prohibition of storage of nuclear waste.  
18 Notwithstanding the provisions of the Western Interstate  
19 Nuclear Compact, no person may store within the state of  
20 Montana any nuclear waste.

21 Section 3. Penalty. A person convicted of violating  
22 this act is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not  
23 less than \$1,000 for each violation. For purposes of this  
24 act, each day of violation constitutes a separate offense.
