 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Article V, section 6 of the Montana
 11 constitution is amended to read as follows:

12 "Section 6. Sessions. The legislature shall ~~meet--each~~
 13 ~~odd-numbered-year--in--regular-session-of-not-more-than-90~~
 14 ~~legislative-days~~ be a continuous body for 2-year periods
 15 beginning when newly elected members take office. Any
 16 legislature may increase the limit on the length of any
 17 subsequent session. The legislature shall meet a maximum of
 18 60 legislative days in odd-numbered years and a maximum of
 19 60 legislative days in even-numbered years. Any business,
 20 bill, or resolution pending at adjournment of the
 21 odd-numbered year session shall carry over with the same
 22 status to any other session of the legislature during the
 23 biennium. Only appropriations, revenue, and committee bills
 24 may be introduced during an even-numbered year session. The
 25 legislature may be convened in special sessions by the

1 governor or at the written request of a majority of the
 2 members."
