The legislature shall meet a maximum of 60 legislative days in odd-numbered years and a maximum of 60 legislative days in even-numbered years. Any business: bill. or resolution pending at adjournment of the odd-numbered year session shall carry over with the same status to any other session of the legislature during the biennium. Only appropriations: revenue, and committee bills may be introduced during an even-numbered year session. The legislature may be convened in special sessions by the

governor or at the written request of a majority of the members."

Section 2. This amendment shall be submitted to the qualified electors of Montana at the general election to be held November 7, 1978, by printing on the ballot the full title, sections 1 and 3 of this act, and the following words:

FOR annual sessions.

AGAINST annual sessions.

Section 3. Effective date. This amendment is effective on January 1 immediately following ratification by the electors.
