DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to amend Section 53-1102, to provide for annual inspection of motor vehicles.

ASSUMPTIONS:

2

- 1. 552,242 vehicles with a gross vehicle weight of less than 8,000 pounds will be inspected each year.
- 2. The cost of each inspection will be \$1.25 and 500 inspection stations will obtain a \$25 license.
- 3. 13 FTE employees will be needed to staff a Vehicle Inspection Bureau in the Motor Vehicle Division of the Department of Justice.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Included in the below costs each year, in addition to other costs, is estimated office space costs (2,000 square feet at \$9,000), data processing development costs (\$16,300), operational data processing costs (\$30,000), printing costs (\$40,000), and travel costs (\$19,000). Also included in FY 78 is the purchase of seven (7) vehicles at a total cost of \$35,000.
