8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 93-100-7, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to read as follows:

*93-100-7. Notice and publication. When such petition is filed in the district court, the court or the judge thereof shall designate some newspaper of general circulation in the county, such as is most likely to give all parties interested notice of the proceedings, and shall order that notice be published therein as hereinafter providedy or, in the alternative, he shall order the posting of notice as hereinafter provided and, in his discretion, he may require any other and further notice that to him may seem reasonable, and shall fix a time at which objections to the granting of the petition for the change of name shall be heard. In accordance with the court's order, * a copy of the petition, together with a notice of the time set for hearing objections thereto, either shall be published in the newspaper designated by the court or judge for that purpose,

at least once a week for four 4 successive weeks or shall be
posted by the clerk of the court at three of the most public

places in the county, at least 10 days before the bearing,
and such other and further notice of the proceedings shall
be given as the court or judge may, in his discretion,
require."
