BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Notice of fire inspection to local fire chief required. Whenever a fire inspection for any purpose is proposed or requested by the state fire marshal or by any other official of the state of Montana or a political subdivision thereof within the area served by a fire department or fire company organized or established under chapter 19 or 20 of Title 11. the person proposing or requesting the fire inspection shall notify the chief of the fire department a reasonable time before commencement of the fire inspection and extend to the chief or a representative designated by him reasonable opportunity to be present at and to observe all phases of the fire inspection.

Section 2. Fire inspections by qualified persons only.

A fire inspection made by or at the request of the state

fire marshal or any other official or agency of the state of

2 Montana or a political subdivision thereof may be made by a

3 person who is: in the opinion of the state fire marshal:

4 qualified to conduct fire inspections by reason of training,

5 education, or experience.
