Any person who shall engage in, or who is at the present time engaged in conducting any taxidermist business, as the term is generally understood, or any person who conducts a business for the purpose of mounting, preserving or preparing any of the dead bodies of any birdsy-or-animals wildlife, or any part thereof, mentioned-in-the-game-laws-of this--states must first obtain from the state fish and game director a taxidermist's license and shall pay an annual license fee of fifteen--dellars--(\$15+80) therefor. Such person shall, keep a written record of all the articles of game wildlife in his possession or control, the kind and number of each, by whom owned, and the residence of owner, also of all the articles of game wildlife shippedy and to

whom and where shipped. The above record shall be kept for at-least-s-period-of-one-(1) year and as long as such articles remain in the possession of the licensee but, in any event, at least 5 years. These records shall be open to inspection by any state game warden at any reasonable time. Any person violating the provisions hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished as provided by section 26-324. In all cases of conviction of violation of this set section, the license of the person convicted shall may be revoked by the court.
