## 3E it enacted by the legislature of the state of montana:

Section 1. Local option law -- petition -- time for election. Upon appication by petition signed by one-third of the voters who are qualified to vote for menbers of the legislature in any county in the state, the board of county comisisioners shall order an election to be heldat the places of holding elections for county officers, to take place within 40 days after the reception of such petition, co determine whether or not any gambling game specifically authorized by statute in this stata may be conducted or geming device specifically authorized by statute may be made available for pley within the county- No election under tiais section may take place in any month in which geaeral elections are held. The board of county commissioners ahall determine the sufficiency of the petition presented froan the roll of rejistered electors of the tirritory affected.

Saction 2. Notice of election. The norice of election

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shall be published once a week for 4 weeks in whatever
newspaper or newspapers of the county wherein the election
is to be held as the board of county commissioners thinks
proper.
Section 3. Ballots - what to contain. The county clerk shall furnish the ballots to be used at the election as provided in the general election law which ballots shall contain the following words: "conducting of the gambling game known as yesm; conducting of the gambing game known as __, now; offering for play, the ganing device known as ___ yes"; mffering for play, the ganing device known as _._ nom; and the elector in order to vote must mark an "X" opposite one of the answers. A single election way include a vote on more than one form of gambling game or gaming device.
Section 4. Elections - how held. The polling place shall be established, the officials to conduct the election shall be designated, and the election shall de held, canvassed, and returned in all respects in conformity with the laws of the state
Section 5. Licenses void if majority vote no. if a majority of the votes cast are "conducting of the gambling game known as ___ no" or "offering for play, the gaming device known as ____ no", the board of county commissioners shall publish the result once a week for 4 weeks in the
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paper in which the notice of the election was given. The provisions of this act shall take effect at the expiration of the time of the publication of the notice, and thereupon al) existing licenses permitting the conducting of gambling ganes or offering for play of gaming devices shall be cancelled.

Section 6. No election more than once in two years. No election under this act may be held in the same county more often than once in 2 years.

Section 7. Conducting of gambling games and offering for play of gaming devices prohibited. If a majority of the votes at the election are conducting of gambling game known as __. no". or "offering for play, the gawing device known as ___ no", it is unlawful for any person within the county in which the vote was taken to conduct or allow to be conducted any gambling game or to make available any gaming device to any person for playe

Section 8. Contested elections. Any election held under the provisions of this act way be contested in the same manner as provided by the general election laws.
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
