(a) at least two (2) members one member TWO MEMBERS shall have having professional qualifications in a human or animal health service licensed by a board within a department of professional and occupational licenses;

(b) at least one member being a doctor of veterinary medicine licensed in this state who derives a portion of his

income from the production of livestock or other agricultural commodities IS ENGAGED IN FOOD ANIMAL MEDICINE;

and

(c) the other members not holding such qualifications shall have demonstrated remainder from citizens demonstrating OTHER MEMBERS NOT HOLDING SUCH QUALIFICATIONS SHALL HAVE DEMONSTRATED intelligent and active interest in the field of public health.

(3) The board is designated as a quasi-judicial board for purposes of section 82A-112 of this act."

Section 2. Implementation. This act shall be implemented at the time the next vacancy on the board of health occurs AS THE NEXT VACANCIES OCCUR ON THE BOARD OF HEALTH, PROVIDED THAT WHEN A PRESENT MEMBER OF THE BOARD IS REAPPOINTED TO A NEW TERM UPON EXPIRATION OF HIS PRESENT TERM, NO VACANCY SHALL BE DEEMED TO HAVE OCCURRED.
