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11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 Section 1. Section 34-5606, R.C.M. 1947, is amended to 13 read as follows:

"84-5606. The tax. (1) All taxes paid pursuant to the 14 provisions of this section shall be conclusively presumed to 15 be direct taxes on the retail consumer precollected for the 16 purpose of convenience and facility only. When the tax is 17 paid by any other persons such payment shall be considered 18 as an advance payment and shall be added to the price of the 19 20 cigarettes and recovered from the ultimate consumer or user. 21 Any person selling cigarettes at retail shall state or 22 separately display in the licensed premises a notice of the tax included in the selling price and charged or payable 23 pursuant to this section. The provisions of this subdivision 24 subsection shall in no way affect the method of collection 25

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1 of such tax as provided by this section.

(2) From and after the effective date of this 2 amendatory law, there is hereby levied, imposed, and 3 assessed, and there shall be collected and paid to the state 4 of Montana, upon cigarettes sold or possessed in this state, 5 the following excise tax which shall be paid prior to the 6 time of sale and delivery thereof, to wit: Nine 2 cents (9g) 7 on each package containing not more than twenty--{20} 8 9 cigarettesy and, when packages shall contain more than 10 twenty-(20) cigarettes, then nine 9 cents (9g) on each 11 twenty--f20) or fraction of twenty-f20) cigarettes contained 12 in such package.

13 (3) From and after the effective date of this amendatory laws there is hereby levied, imposeds and 14 15 assessedy and there shall be collected and paid to the state of Montana, upon cigarettes sold or possessed in this state, 16 17 the following excise tax, in addition to the excise tax on cigarettesy levied, imposed, and assessed by subdivision 13 subsection (2) of this section 84-5686, an additional tax 19 which shall be paid prior to the time of sale and delivery 20 of such cigarettes, to wit: Two 2 cents (2g) on each 21 package containing not more than twenty-{20} cigarettesy 22 and when packages shall contain more than twenty--(20) 23 cigarettes, then two 2 cents (2#) on each twenty-(20) or 24 fraction of twenty--f20; cigarettes contained in such 25

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1 package; which additional tax shall continue in force uptil 2 the payment and retirement of all bonds of the state of 3 Montana, and the payment of interest thereon, issued under 4 the authority of said Initiative No. 54, as amended, for the 5 purpose of paying an honorarium to the residents of Montana 6 who were in military service in the military forces of the 7 United States in World War II, the Korean War, or в World War Iv and until the payment and retirement of all 9 long-range building program bonds issued under the provisions of Title 79, chapter 22,-of-the-Revised-Codes-of 10 Montenev-1947. 11

12 (4) From and after the effective date of this 13 amendatory act of the thirty-eighth legislative assembly of 14 the state of Montana, there is hereby levied, imposed, and 15 assessedy and there shall be collected and paid to the state of Montana, upon cigarettes sold or possessed in this state, 16 17 the following excise tax, in addition to the excise tax on 18 cigarettes, levied, imposeds and assessed by subdivisions 19 subsections (2) and (3) of this section 84-5686, an additional tax which shall be paid prior to the time of sale 20 21 and delivery of such cigarettes, to wit: One 1 cent (12) on 22 each package containing not more than twenty--{20} cigarettesy and, when packages shall contain more than 23 twenty--{20} cigarettes, then one 1 cent (if) on each twenty 24 25 (20) or fraction of twenty-(20) cigarettes contained in such

1 package; which additional tax shall continue in force until Z the payment and retirement of the additional bonds of the 3 state of Montana authorized by amendatory acts of the 4 thirty-fifth and thirty-eighth legislative assemblies, and 5 the payment of the interest thereon and until the payment 6 and retirement of all long-range building program bonds 7 issued under the provisions of Title 79, chapter 22y-of--the 8 Revised-Codes-of-Montanay-1947. 9 (5) As of the effective date of this amendatory act of 10 the 45th legislature, there is levied, imposed, and assessed 11 and there shall be collected and paid to the state of 12 Montana, upon cigarettes sold or possessed in this state. 13 the following excise tax, in addition to the excise tax on 14 cigarettes provided for in subsections (2), (3), and (4) of 15 this section: which shall be paid prior to the time of sale 16 and delivery of the cigarettes: 5 cents on each package 17 containing not more than 20 cigarettes and, when a package 18 contains more than 20 cigarettes, 5 cents on each 20 or 19 fraction of 20 cigarettes contained in the package. The 20 revenue obtained from the additional tax shall be deposited 21 in the earmarked revenue fund for the use of the department 22 of health\_and\_environmental\_sciences\_to\_fund\_such\_duties\_as 23 may be imposed on it by the 45th legislature of this state. 151(6) Within seventy-two-f72; hours after receipt by 24

25 the distributor or dealer of any such cigarettes, except as

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1 hereinafter provided, he shall cause to be securely affixed 2 theretow the required insignia denoting the tax thereon. 3 Said insignia shall be properly canceled prior to sale or 4 removal for consumption under such regulations as the board 5 may prescribe. Each package shall have the required insignia 6 to affix thereto in such a manner that the insignia will be 7 destroyed when the package is opened. Every person who shall make, alter, forger or counterfeit any license stamp or 8 9 insignia provided for in this law, or who shall assist or be 10 concerned therein, or who shall have in his possession any 11 altered, forged, counterfeit, or spurious stamp, license, or 12 insignia, with intent to defraud the state, is guilty of 13 forgeryw and shall be punished by imprisonment in the state 14 prison for not less than one-fly year or more than fourteen 15 <del>(</del>14<del>)</del> years."

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to impose an additional excise tax on cigarettes of five (5) cents a package and to earmark the revenue obtained from such tax for the use of the Department of Health and Environmental Sciences to fund such duties as the legislature may impose.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The number of packages of cigarettes sold in FY 78 will be 95,230,000 and in FY 79 97,136,000 packages.

2. Administrative costs will not increase.
